What are ENC charts?

Electronic Navigational Charts (ENCs) are official vector charts designed to meet the relevant chart carriage requirements of the Safety of Life At Sea (SOLAS) Convention. An ENC must be produced in content, format and structure to the International Hydrographic Organisation (IHO) S57 ENC product specification.

ENCs consist of digitised data that record all relevant chart features such as coastlines, buoys, lights, etc. These features and their attributes (position, colour, shape) are held in a database that allows them to be selectively displayed and queried, and for alarms and warnings to be generated.

Paper equivalence

ENCs are fully compliant with the IHO S57 format. ENC data can only be issued by or on the authority of a government-authorized Hydrographic Office. Each country is therefore responsible for producing its own ENCs, and then systematically updating them with all safety-critical information.

ENC Availability

For an up-to-date overview visit the IHO web-site www.iho.shom.fr or www.ic-enc.org. All ENCs are supplied on an annual subscription basis inclusive of a weekly updating service.

CM-ENCs

CM-ENCs are official S-57 ENC charts supplied by Hydrographic Offices to C-Map Norway and pre-compiled into C-Map's approved "System ENC" delivery format. This format reduces the installation time periods for the user. CM-ENCs cost \$24 per standard chart cell (approximately the equivalent of a full-size paper chart.) A minimum fee of \$100 applies for a new subscription.

Admiralty ENCs

Admiralty ENC standard chart cells cost \$24, with other options for Small @ \$8, Medium @ \$16, Large @ \$45. A minimum fee of \$250 applies for a new subscription.

Admiralty ECDIS Service – ENC and ARCS

The Admiralty offer a combined ENC and ARCS service. Please contact PC Maritime if you wish to know more.

PRIMAR ENCs

PRIMAR¹ ENCs cost \$24 per standard chart cell. Go to www.primar-stavanger.org to view chart availability. A minimum fee of \$100 applies. Weekly Updates can be provided on CD at a cost of US\$3 dollars each.

CHS (Canadian Hydrographic Service) ENCs

Canadian ENCs are available for all Canadian waters. Known as Digital Ocean Professional charts, the cost is \$1,999 for a region or \$25 per individual ENC. Go to www.DigitalOcean.ca/digitalocean to see diagrams of the regions covered.

ENC Weekly Updates on CD - Delivery
