High-performance AIS package from PC Maritime

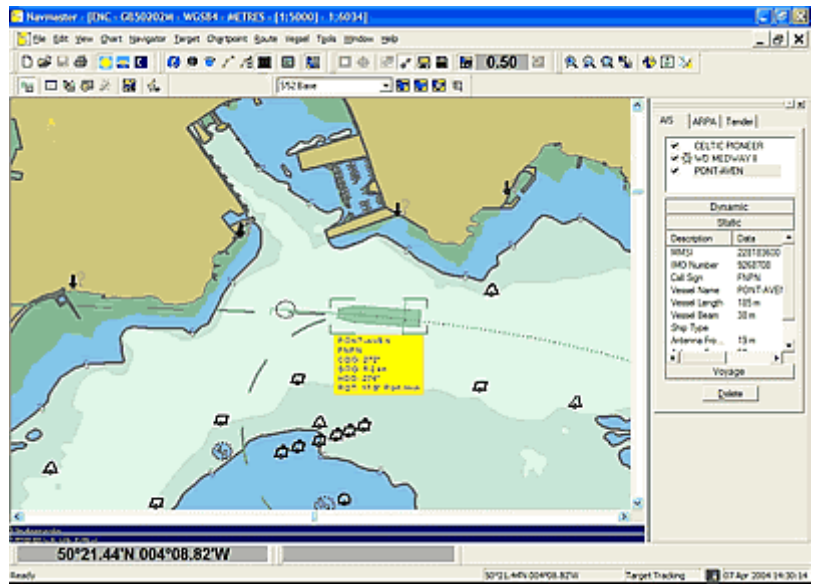
